FAT-GRAFTING PROCEDURES GROW IN POPULARITY IN TAMPA BAY

Thanks to advances in science and more control in where patients have their procedures performed, the appearance of aging can be offset at any stage. According to the American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS), there were 14.6 million cosmetic plastic surgery procedures performed last year alone. Facial rejuvenation procedures experienced the most growth, such as the latest minimally invasive techniques in fat grafting, and breast augmentation remains the most popular.

Sometimes referred to as fat transfer or fat injections, the fat-grafting procedure removes a patient's own fat to re-implant it where needed. It is typically extracted from body parts like the abdomen or thighs and injected into another area that requires plumping, such as a patient's facial features. Although the fat grafting concept has a two-century-long history, it was not until the introduction of liposuction in the 1970s that surgeons were able to access the amount of fat needed to effectively increase the survival of fat cells and the needed corresponding blood supply to the transplanted area.

"Twenty years ago, fat grafting was still considered a controversial procedure to perform," explains Daniel Diaco, M.D., FACS, board certified plastic surgeon of the Diaco Institute of Plastic Surgery in Tampa Bay. "But now, I perform up to eight fat-grafting procedures on face, breast and buttocks every month. Many patients who are looking for an implant-free method of breast or buttocks augmentation choose this and are pleased with the long-lasting and naturalappearing results, along with the wonderful side benefit of liposuction."

According to The American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery, fat grafting is a safe, usually minimally invasive, method to rejuvenate the body and spares the patient from inherent risks
